Pre & Post Matric Scholarship under Centrally Sponsored Scheme to students belonging to ST community

Port Blair, Oct. 10

The Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt. of India proposes to provide Pre and Post Matric Scholarship under Centrally Sponsored Scheme to the students belonging to Scheduled Tribe community notified by the A&N Islands studying at Secondary, Higher Secondary, Graduation and Post Graduation level for the academic year 2021-22. The scholarship criteria required are as mentioned below:

Pre Matric Scholarship	Post Matric Scholarship
i) Applicable to students who are studying in Classes IX – X.	i) Applicable to students who are studying in any recognized course from a recognized institution for which qualification is Matriculation/Class XI and above.
ii) Parental income from all sources shall be less than Rs.2.00 lakhs per annum.	ii) Parental income from all sources shall be less than Rs.2.50 lakhs per annum.
iii) Scholarship of Rs.225/- per month for day scholars and Rs.525/- per month for hostellers is given for a period of 10 months in a year.	iii) Compulsory fees charged by educational institutions are reimbursed subject to the limit fixed by the concerned State Fee Fixation Committee and scholarship amount of Rs.230/- to Rs.1200 per month, depending upon the course of study is paid.

The portal is open and the last date for filling NSP scholarship application form by the ST students is Nov. 30, 2021. The willing and eligible ST students can apply for the Pre & Post Matric Scholarship by logging in the official web portal i.e. <https://scholarships.gov.in/>. The value of scholarship 'course-wise' is given in the guidelines which are available on <https://scholarships.gov.in/>. 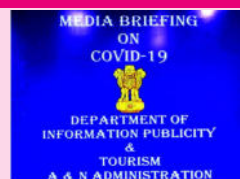

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Mitta Champa - a local banana cultivar

Mitta Champa is a local cultivar in the Island and cultivated since ages and more prevalent in Andaman group of Islands. This variety is slowly vanishing from the Island as per the information received from farmers of South Andaman. This cultivar is grown in homestead gardens and most preferred for table purpose. The variety is medium sized growing to a height of 2-2.5 m. Fruits are medium sized with shiny silky skin, very sweet in taste and turns to golden yellow on ripening. Bunch weight varies from 15- 20 Kg and number of hands per bunch varies from 12-14 with 10-12 fingers per hand. The keeping quality of the fruits is less and the skin tends to turn black after 3 days of ripening. The average weight of fruit ranges from 80-100 g. This cultivar is maintained with traditional farmers' of the Island and the reduction in yield is observed when grown as a ratoon crop continuously. It is of utmost importance to conserve this local variety and its cultivation is to be encouraged.

Benefit: This cultivar is highly suitable to grow as intercrop in plantation based cropping system and is also highly suitable for high density planting.

World Mental Health Day observed Mental Health is a silent killer like Diabetes: Health Minister

New Delhi, Oct. 10 (PIB)

Dr Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare chaired an event to observe the World Mental Health Day today at the National Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences (N I M H A N S) Bengaluru. In his address, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya cautioned that Mental Health is a silent killer in the country like Diabetes: "While Diabetes becomes fatal because it often goes undetected, people with Mental Health do not come forward because of stigma." He noted that change in our lifestyle and family structure as a prime culprit for the recent rise in mental health cases. He said, "Hospital is the final step. Family can spot early signs of distress in fellow members and seek help before the



problem worsens. Similarly, teachers may spot behavioral changes in their pupils and offer solutions. Such steps will nip the problem in the bud." Dr. Mandaviya observed that Government and Society can function only in sync. More research needs to be done in Mental Health on which the future policy of Government will rest where old and renowned institutes like NIMHANS, established as early as 1936 come into the picture.

Citing the lack of Mental Health-care practitioners, the Union Health Minister emphasized that education oriented only towards marks do not help the nation. He exhorted the students to take up cases and opt for hands on learning in the healing of those requiring care. Dr Mansukh M a n d a v i y a congratulating the pass-outs said, "Around 1.36 lakh people commit suicide according to the Police Bureau. They do so because they are suffering from some mental health issues. We have to build Healthy Nation. Only Healthy Citizen can make Healthy Society which in turn build a Healthy Nation.

India's cumulative COVID-19 vaccination coverage crosses the landmark of 94 Cr.

New Delhi, Oct. 10 (PIB)

With the administration of 66,85,415 vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage crossed the landmark of 94 Cr (94,70,10,175) as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 92,12,314 sessions. The recovery of 23,624 patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to 3,32,71,915.

Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at 97.99%. Recovery Rate is

currently at its highest peak since March 2020. Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/ UTs continue the trend of less than 50,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for 105 consecutive days now. 18,166 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours. This is the lowest recorded daily new cases in 214 days.The Active Caseload is presently 2,30,971, which is the lowest in 208 days. Active cases presently constitute 0.68% of the country's total Positive Cases.

The testing capacity

across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of 12,83,212 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over 58.25 Cr (58,25,95,693) cumulative tests. While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, Weekly Positivity Rate at 1.57% remains less than 3% for the last 107 days now. The Daily Positivity Rate reported to be 1.42%. The daily Positivity Rate has remained below 3% for last 41 days and below 5% for 124 consecutive days now.
